Information That Can Help Emergency Personnel

- Your location is 700 Golden Beach Blvd, Venice, FL
- Provide location on the property where they are needed (e.g. unit #, pool, high rise, parking lot) and any directions to help quickly locate you or this location
- Provide the best gate to enter: North, South, Fire Trucks (south of Mid-Rise and South gate)
- If possible, have someone meet the emergency vehicle at gate
- ... and of course, the nature of the emergency

Location of Safety Equipment

Fire Extinguishers

High Rise - central hallway on each floor
Low Rise and Mid-rise - outside the unit doors

Fire alarm pull – each floor of high rise

Emergency Phone

Outside the High Rise north entry door

Defibrillators

High Rise near public bathroom
Low Rise laundry room

Ladders

High Rise under building storage area-
north east hallway

CodeRED notifications:

Drinking water contamination, Extended utility outages, Evacuation notice and route
Fires, floods, bombs, chemical spills, other life threatening situations
Opt-in weather warning service when registered for tornado, flash flood, severe storms

Where to Go: Basic Rules of Thumb

Tornado: Lowest level and inner most room without windows (e.g. 1st floor hall in High Rise)

Hurricane: “Run from water, Hide from wind”. Evacuate the Island further inland to a sturdy structure and if possible out of the storm path. Plan ahead and leave early.
